

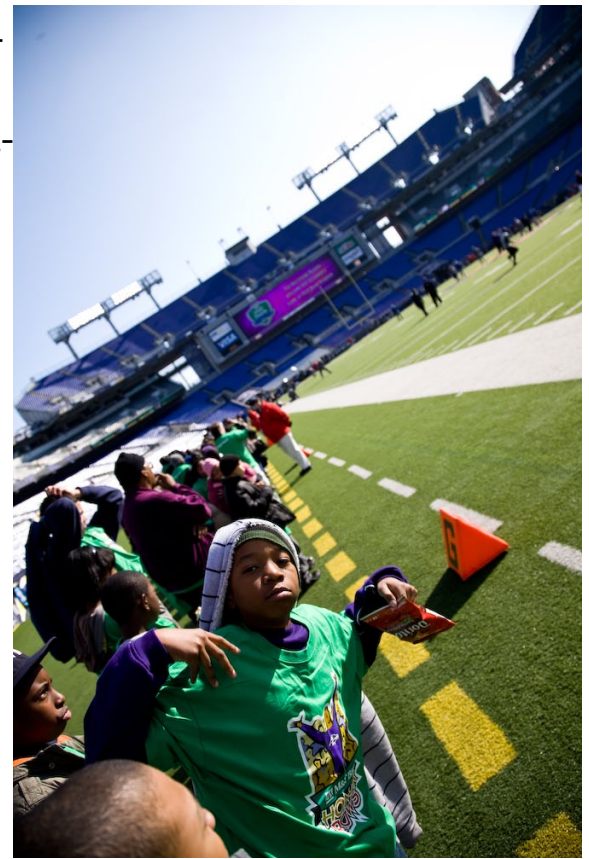
Bridges goes to the Ravens Game!
