

Bridges at Gilman Continues with an After School Program

Bridges at Gilman's inaugural class of fourth and fifth grade students returned to Gilman in November for the start of the Bridges After School Program. This program runs from November – May and provides each elementary aged student with weekly one-on-one tutoring, reading support, recess games, and their very own high school volunteer from Gilman School or from Bryn Mawr School.

The winter session was wildly popular, with 22 student participants who had a total 98% attendance rate. They were joined by 11 high school students who volunteered a total of 600 hours working one-on-one with students during their Tuesday and Wednesday sessions.
