

Bridges Winter After-School Tutoring

November 2010-February 2011

This winter, 28 high school students from St. Paul's School and St. Paul's School for Girls volunteered nearly 500 hours in the Bridges Winter After School Program. Volunteers provided weekly tutor mentoring to 31 Bridges fourth and fifth grade students. Sessions ran Tuesday through Friday from November to February. Each 90 minute meeting started with sports, followed by a group reading from *Diary of a Wimpy Kid: Rodrick Rules*, and concluded with one-on-one homework help. Volunteers also participated in a Monday training and planning session.
